A Bylaw to Provide for the Enforcement of the Bylaws of the Municipality pursuant to The Municipalities Act

Rural Municipality of Lakeland No. 521

BYLAW NO. 1 of 2010

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lakeland No. 521 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw”.
2. “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Lakeland No. 521
3. Section 5 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. No person shall provide a false or misleading statement to the any Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Designated Officer, Peace Officer or person appointed to enforce any Bylaw of the Municipality.
5. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
6. Bylaw No. 3 - 1990 is hereby repealed
