Yard Refuse Policy

The District of Lakeland has adopted a new policy regarding the depositing of yard refuse, tree branches, leaves, grass clippings and other compostable materials into the Emma Lake Landfill. Effective July 18, 2016, ratepayers and participating partners will be able to deposit the above noted items at the landfill "FREE OF CHARGE" on a year round basis. The District anticipates that this will reduce the amount of material being deposited into the natural wooded areas within the municipality thereby reducing the potential fire hazard. PLEASE NOTE THIS IS FOR YARD REFUSE ONLY - CHARGES APPLY FOR ALL OTHER ITEMS.



Block Party Policy

Pursuant to requests from ratepayers, the District of Lakeland No. 521 is pleased to announce the implementation of the new Block Party Policy. This concept is seen as an innovative way for the subdivisions and neighborhoods in the municipality to come together and meet and socialize with their neighbors. Ratepayers are advised that 2017 will be a revaluation year for all assessed properties in Saskatchewan. The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency conducts revaluations every four (4) years with the last one conducted in 2013. The revaluation will see assessed values updated to reflect a new base date or property value as of January 1, 2015.
