2015 Forest Fires

In the morning of June 26, 2015 the District of Lakeland declared a fire ban within the municipality. This was only the second ever fire ban issued by the municipality in recent memory. That fire ban went on for 22 days.

While any immediate emergency and threat to the municipality was never realized, the threat of fire to our area was real.

Thank you to everyone who helped keep our community safe by not having that campfire! Your sacrifice helped us, and the province, keep our community safe and reduced threats of forest fires.

Now that the fire ban is off, please continue to practice safe burning. This means never leave a fire unattended, control your flame (avoid big bonfires), keep fuels and combustibles away from your fire, and have a fire extinguisher, water or other device available to extinguish your fire if needed.

Municipal Tax Discounts & Penalties

Are due by August 31, 2015.

- Are due **in our office** by the 31st of the month.
- 1% penalty will be added on each month your taxes are overdue.
- Early payment discounts start in January at 6% and go down 1% monthly until July there is 0% discount. The discount is calculated on the municipal portion of your taxes only. The discount is based on last year's taxes and is only an estimate. Please check your tax notice when it arrives to see if you have a balance left owing.
- Taxes are payable by Cheque, cash, debit machine in our office, e-transfers and on line banking – (BMO/Scotia/Credit-Union banks).
- Tax notices were mailed out in late June. If you did not receive yours please call our office at 306 982-2010. Please remember to update your address if you have recently moved.
- The mill rate for 2015 will remain the same as in 2014 for both the school portion and the municipal portion of your taxes.
