BEACHES AND PUBLIC RESERVES

There are several activities that are not permitted within our beaches and public reserve areas.



Please keep your animal off of public beaches. If you are walking your animal on public property it must be leashed and under your direct control.



Consuming beverage alcohol is illegal in all public areas. If you choose to drink please do so within your private property or at one of our licenced establishments.



Camping, including the parking of camper trailers, is not permitted. If you want to camp please use a licensed campground or the Great Blue Heron Provincial Park.

PARKING ... NO PARKING

Throughout Lakeland there are many no parking areas. This is to ensure free and safe passage of pedestrian and vehicle traffic. This includes ensuring emergency vehicles can get to the emergency if needed.

Some areas include;

- Undeveloped side of Neis Drive
- South side of Commercial Drive
- South side of Baron Avenue and Francis Avenue
- Undeveloped (east) side of Okema Trail
- Undeveloped (west) side of Douglas Drive and Derek Place

Persons who park in parks, reserves and designated no parking areas are liable to have your vehicle ticketed and towed. Vehicles will be released once the cost of any tow and impound are paid.

There are areas designated as no parking during specific periods. This includes beaches (midnight to 6 am), Sunnyside Public Parking Lot (3 am to 6 am). These areas also are ticket and tow areas.

Should your vehicle be towed you may claim it be calling 306-982-4466 to arrange its release.

There have also been temporary parking spots created to assist in off street parking. These designated parking areas are for short period temporary parking. These parking spots are for single motor vehicle only. Campers, trailers or other storage will be towed.
