#### **CODE RED**

*The District of Lakeland No. 521 has signed a contract with a US based company (Code Red) that will enhance the municipality's ability to provide mass emergency notification to our ratepayers in the event of an emergency incident. Ratepayers and visitors will be able to subscribe to this service free of charge and receive notifications on a variety of media devices (ie, ipad, iphones, landlines, etc). At a cost of \$1500 US per year to the municipality, it is anticipated that the system will be operational by mid 2016. Ratepayers will be encouraged to subscribe to this system through our website.*

*In addition, the municipality is also registered with Sask Alert which facilitates emergency notifications through the local media outlets broadcasting in the area.*



### **Municipal Shop**

*The new municipal shop has been completed and the Public Works Staff are enjoying their new home. Equipment storage and repairs can be completed indoors during inclement weather. The former municipal compound has been converted to a storage yard for the Enforcement and Protective Services department as well as the site for the recycling bins recently moved from the Ambrose entrance location.*

### **Highway #263**

*The reconstruction of Highway #263 is continuing with completion scheduled for the fall of 2016. Seasonal conditions throughout the summer - rain, smoke etc have hampered progress on the project. The District is pleased with the cooperation from the contractor and traffic disruption was at a minimum.*

### **Drainage**

*The District of Lakeland No 521 has encountered several drainage issues on Carwin Park Drive as a result of the reconstruction of Highway #952 (Murray Point Highway) several years ago. We are pleased to announce that the Ministry of Highways has provided \$20,000 to the Municipality to assist in offsetting some of the costs associated with the drainage issues.*
