## Golf Cart Bylaw Need to Knows:

Questions? Call the District office

- Obtain your annual permit/plate from the District Office
- Operators must have a minimum valid class 7 drivers license
- Operators must carry liability insurance
- Slow-moving vehicle signage must be displayed on the back of the cart
- Carts can be operated during daylight hours on municipal roadways
