2024 ELECTION

The District of Lakeland No. 521 Municipal Election will be held Saturday, July 27, 2024. This page provides information on who can run in the election, nomination timelines, and details on who can vote and how. This page will be updated as there is new information to share.

- Electing Reeve and 5 Councillors: Starting May 3, 2024, candidates can pick up the Nomination Paper, Candidates Acceptance, and the Public Disclosure Statement at the District office.
- **Call for Nominations:** Starting Friday, May 3, 2024, nominations will be accepted at the District Office during business hours.
- Closing of Nominations: Must be received on or before Saturday, June 22, 2024, at the District Office. (The District office will be open from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on June 22nd for any last-day nomination submissions.)
- Advance Poll: July 20, 2024, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the District office Council Chambers.
- **Election Day:** Saturday July 27, 2024, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the District Office Council Chambers.

• Candidate Eligibility:

- Candidates must be at least 18 years old on election day.
- Candidates must not be disqualified by any Act.
- Candidates must be Canadian citizens upon submitting the nomination paper.
- For resort village elections:
 - Candidates must have resided in the resort village for at least three consecutive months prior to submitting the nomination paper.
 - Is the assessed person of property in the resort village for three consecutive months prior to submitting the nomination paper.
 - Is the spouse of a person mentioned above.

• Voter Eligibility:

- o Eligible voters must be Canadian citizens.
- Eligible voters must be at least 18 years old.
- For resort village elections:
 - Eligible voters must have resided in the resort village for at least three consecutive months before election day.
 - Is the accessed person of property in the resort village, for three consecutive months before election day.
 - Is the spouse of a person mentioned above.

Voter Identification:

- There will be no voters list; instead, voters must provide identification.
- Acceptable forms of identification include birth certificates, driver's licenses, and passports.
